

Insufficient Lack of Information Start of Care Timeframes



Driscoll Health Plan will honor the Start of Care (SOC) date, for STAR and STAR Kids Members, when the Provider requesting the services submits the prior authorization request in a timely manner, as referenced in the table below, with complete clinical information and/or documents to support medical necessity and Driscoll Health Plan has determined the requested services meet medical necessity from the Start of Care date.

Driscoll Health Plan will not consider service dates provided to the Member prior to the request received date if the Provider does not submit the request in a timely manner. Start date of the prior authorization request will default to the received date.

During the authorization process, providers are required to deliver the requested services from the Start of Care date.
