# BECOMING AN OEFV PROVIDER

STEPS ON BECOMING AN ORAL  
EVALUATION AND FLUORIDE  
VARNISH (OEFV) PROVIDER



## The steps to becoming an OEFV Provider:

- To be certified to bill Medicaid for Oral Evaluation and Fluoride Varnish services, you must be enrolled as a provider in Texas Medicaid and Texas Health Steps.
- You must also complete the following requirements:
  - Complete the Oral Evaluation and Fluoride Varnish training and obtain a **CE training certificate**. The training course can be found here: [txhealthsteps.com/695-oral-evaluation-and-fluoride-varnish](https://txhealthsteps.com/695-oral-evaluation-and-fluoride-varnish)
  - Complete an Oral Evaluation and Fluoride Varnish (**OEFV**) **Certification Application**: [hhs.texas.gov/sites/default/files/documents/laws-regulations/forms/1090/1090.pdf](https://hhs.texas.gov/sites/default/files/documents/laws-regulations/forms/1090/1090.pdf)
  - Submit the **OEFV Certification Application** and the **CE training certificate** to [THStepsOEFV.FDH@hpsc.state.tx.us](mailto:THStepsOEFV.FDH@hpsc.state.tx.us) or fax to 512-483-3979.
- Completion of this training is recommended for all members of a provider's team who will be assisting with OEFV services.
- Providers must be certified only once to provide OEFV services. There is no requirement to retake the training or submit a new application.
